Warrandyte Community Association Achievements

WCA has an active Committee of Management elected annually by the membership. It meets monthly and holds public meetings and forums. We encourage members to participate and be active in community affairs.

Local and State Government

We have held regular meetings, workshops and community activities with Local and State Government to influence specific issues. Our annual 'Meet the Pollies' forum is well attended.

Retirement Accommodation

We created a sub-committee which became an incorporated Co-operative which is working on the provision of retirement housing in the township.

Town Planning and Development

We supported local management of the Warrandyte Community Centre. We are very active in monitoring developments to maintain planning and heritage standards and assist individual residents with submissions to council.

Traffic, Transport and Emergency Planning

We conducted a public transport survey to improve public transport. We lobby for a network of foot and bike paths, unobtrusive parking and better communication on emergency services.

Environment

We successfully lobbied for increased funding of the State Park. We represent the community at VCAT to preserve environmental quality in new developments. We lobby to maintain water quality and river-bank erosion.

Youth, Sport and Recreation

We have studied the special requirements of young people within the township helping to establish netball facilities for young women and adventure canoeing for primary age students.
